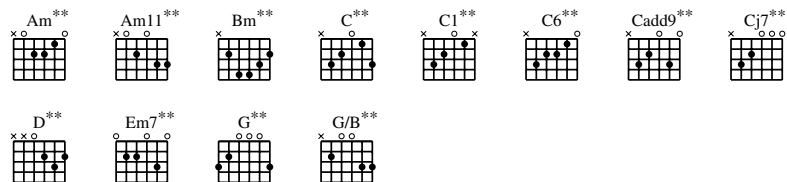

Play the A with your first finger barree on the second fret.  
D/A as A6sus4, keeping the A-chord fingerd and adding ring and  
finger. Adding then your pinky on the 5th fret of the A-string  
to the here used form of D and moving two frets up, to the E.  
The voicing of the D6 is similar to Bm, so it can be seen as B
